WHAT TO PACK

Clothing

2 long-sleeved shirts

4 or five short sleeve shirts or T-shirts

2 pairs of shorts

2 pairs of long pants or pants that zip off into shorts. Blue jeans are not recommended: too heavy and take forever to dry

2 pair of socks

1 pair of compression socks rated 30 or higher. Measure your calf width before ordering!

Good quality polarized sunglasses

Sun hat with a brim

Good walking shoes (running/tennis shoes are fine) Hiking boots not necessary and too heavy to pack!

Sandals or rubber flip/flops

Swimsuit with light cover-up garment

Lightweight jacket or full zippered fleece for cooler mornings

Light raincoat

A set of smart casual evening wear; skirt, scarves or necklace for the ladies

5 pairs of underwear

Toiletries

Personal toiletries (shampoo and conditioner supplied by many establishments)

Moisturizing cream & suntan lotion

Lip balm

Insect repellent e.g. Deet, OFF, etc.

Basic medical kit (aspirins, Bandaids, anti-diarrheal medication, antiseptic cream, and anti-histamine cream, etc.)

Toothbrush and toothpaste

Packaged wet tissues ("Wash & Dry" "Wet Ones")

If you wear contact lenses, a pair of glasses in case you get eye irritation

Reading glasses

Spare pair or older pair of glasses or contact lenses.

Small sewing kit

Small travel packets of Tide or other clothes detergent for washing out underwear and socks.

Other Things To Pack

Visas, tickets, passports, money, etc.

Two Photocopies of your passport

Photo of your suitcases

Backpack to use during the day as you tour

A small flashlight with new batteries or Flashlight APP on your Smart Phone

Adapter plugs

Electric converter for electrical appliances if they DON'T say 100v-240v on the appliance

Smart Phone or tablet

Binoculars

Reading material (or upload to tablet)

Journal with pen

Travel neck pillow for flights

Small roll of gorilla tape or duct tape

Camera Equipment

Camera, memory cards and chargers

Lenses, cleaning fluid, lens tissue

Waterproof/dustproof bags/cover or large ZipLock bag for your camera

Things handy to upload onto your Smartphone or tablet

Reading material

Pdf of camera manual downloaded from the camera manufacturer's website

Photo of your passport ID page

Photo of your airline's ETickets

Photos of your suitcases (to describe if lost by airline)

APPS: free messaging with Viber or WhatsApp, Currency Converter APP, your airline's APP, Flashlight APP
